Authorizing the Safety-Service Director to execute a Contract retroactive to July 1, 2017 on behalf of the City's Department of Regional Community Advancement to provide Administrative/Clerical Services for the Richland County Youth and Family Council, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City's Department of Regional Community Advancement has a staff person(s) qualified to provide the Administrative/Clerical Services sought by the Richland County Youth and Family Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety-Service Director be, and she is hereby, authorized to execute, on behalf of the City's Department of Regional Community Advancement, a Contract retroactive to July 1, 2017 with the Richland County Youth and Family Council, for the provision of a staff person(s) to perform Administrative/Clerical Services under said Contract. This Contract shall be commencing July 1, 2017 and running through June 30, 2018. Said Contract is on file in the City's Department of Regional Community Development.

SECTION 2. That the moneys received from the performance of the contract services authorized in Section 1 hereof, which are not to exceed Fifty-four Thousand Four Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$54,470), shall be deposited in the Regional Community Advancement Fund.

That by reason of the immediate necessity to enter into the subject contract so as to provide such needed services without delay to the Richland County Youth and Family Council, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Mansfield its inhabitants and providing it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its adoption, otherwise from and after the earliest time allowed by law after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
