Subject: Middle Bellville Road Construction

Mansfield, Ohio--

Work continues on Middle Bellville Road. Effective, Monday, August 21, the contractor, Underground Utilities, Inc., will reopen the intersection of Logan Road and Middle Bellville Road. The intersection will be accessible from three directions: north, east and west. The south leg of the intersection will remain closed to through traffic.

A temporary traffic signal has been erected at the Logan Road intersection due to a delay in the delivery of steel signal poles. The contractor is expected to construct the permanent signal at this location in October.

The contractor continues to work on the last major phase of the project, which is the reconstruction of Middle Bellville Road between Logan Road and Holiday Drive. Access to this section of Middle Bellville Road is restricted to local traffic only. Motorists are directed to use the posted detours on Cook Road, Lexington Avenue and South Main Street.

Weather permitting, the major construction activities are expected to be completed by the end of October. A final surface course of asphalt will be placed at the conclusion of the project.
