

In line with guidance issued by the IRS and Ohio Department of Taxation, the City of Mansfield deadline to file and pay city income tax will be extended to July 15.

H.B. 197, passed by the Ohio General Assembly and signed by Governor Mike DeWine waives interest charges on payments made during the extension. The city will not assess penalty amounts on payments during the extension.

The filing extension and waiver of penalty and interest will apply to individuals filing the Mansfield individual income tax and businesses filing municipal net profit returns for tax year 2019. Individuals and businesses required to make quarterly estimated payments will also have additional time to make first and second quarter payments. Payments normally due on April 15 and June 15 will now be due on July 15.

The filing extension **does not** apply to employer filing and payments of withholding.
