The City of Mansfield has prepared an updated DBE Program for Fiscal Years (FY) 2020, 2021, and 2022. Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation has been identified in accordance with Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 26, Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in Department of Transportation Financial Assistance Programs.

Consultation:

In establishing the overall goal, the City of Mansfield will provide for consultation and publication. This process will include consultation with minority, women's, and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which could be expected to have information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs, and the City's efforts to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs.

The consultation will include a scheduled, direct, interactive exchange with as many interested stakeholders as possible, focused on obtaining information relevant to the goal setting process, and will be conducted before the goal methodology is submitted to the Federal Aviation Administration for review.
