Amending Sections 5 and 7 of Ordinance No. 23-006 adopting personnel positions, pay grades, and salaries for certain employees of the City of Mansfield 2023 payroll year, by retitling and increasing the pay grade for a position in the Clearfork Reservoir Division and increasing the salary for a position in the Engineering Division, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 1 through 38 of Ordinance No. 23-006, passed January 3, 2023, this Council adopted certain personnel positions, pay grades and salaries for certain employees of the City of Mansfield for the 2023 payroll year, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 of said Ordinance positions and pay rates are outlined for the Clearfork Reservoir Division and it has become necessary to retitle and increase the grade for a position in that Division to promote safety and provide better services to the community, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7 of said Ordinance it has become necessary to increase the salary for a position in the Engineering Division due to a recent certification earned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 23-006, passed January 3, 2023, be, and the same is hereby amended to read and provide as follows:

<u>"SECTION 5.</u> **CLEARFORK RESERVOIR DIVISION - PERSONNEL.** The Clearfork Reservoir Division within the Public Service Department shall be composed of the following personnel who shall be compensated in accordance with the salary range, pay grade, or hourly rates indicated:

<u>"SECTION 7.</u> **ENGINEERING DIVISION – PERSONNEL.** The Engineering Division within the Public Service Department shall be composed of the following personnel who shall be compensated in accordance with the salary range, pay grade, or hourly rates indicated:

That by reason of the immediate necessity to retitle a position in the Clearfork Reservoir Division to better fit the needs of the City and the Mansfield community and increase the salary range for a position in the Engineering Division, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Mansfield and its inhabitants and providing it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect, and be in force immediately upon its adoption, otherwise from and after the earliest time allowed by law, after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

Authorizing the Interim Safety-Service Director to purchase, according to STS pricing contract criteria, from Jim Shorkey Auto Group, four (4) 2023 Dodge Durango Pursuit AWD Vehicles for the Police Department, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City has \$186,498.00 appropriated and available in the Safety Services Fund (#214) for the purchase, and

WHEREAS, the City has at least \$69,544.24 remaining from funds previously allocated for police cruisers in the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Fund (#221) to complete the purchase.

That the Interim Safety-Service Director be, and is hereby, authorized to purchase, without competitive bidding, from Jim Shorkey Auto Group (1339 Route 30 North Huntingdon, PA 15642), four (4) 2023 Dodge Durango Pursuit AWD Vehicles, along with related equipment from other miscellaneous vendors including Parr Public Safety Equipment, for the Police Department at a cost not to exceed two hundred fifty-six thousand, forty-two and 24/100 dollars (\$256,042.24).

SECTION 2. That the amount authorized under Section 1, not to exceed two hundred fifty-six thousand, forty-two and 24/100 dollars (\$256,042.24), shall be partially paid from the Safety Services Fund (#214) Police Department Operations (214.15.01) Capital Outlay Classification in the amount of \$186,498.00, and the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Fund (#221) Revenue Replacement, Non-departmental Expenditures (221.99.99) Other Charges Classification in the amount of \$69.544.24, of which \$61,250.98 is hereby re-appropriated from the unappropriated American Rescue Plan Fund (#221).

That by reason of the immediate necessity for purchasing this equipment as quickly as possible to perform necessary police operations, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Mansfield and its inhabitants and providing it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption, otherwise from and after the earliest time allowed by law, after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
