REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING February 21, 2023

The second monthly meeting of Mansfield City Council met on Tuesday February 21, 2023 at 7:46 pm in the Council Chambers of the City Building.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by the audience.

Eleazer Akuchie led the audience in prayer.
