K-9 Richy is a German Shepherd, born in 2013 in the Czech Republic, and his primary language is German. He joined the Mansfield Police Department on July 16, 2016. He was certified with his handler Patrol Officer Denny E. Kiner on December 18, 2016, and has been on the road ever since.

Throughout his many years of service, K-9 Richy has had hundreds of drug seizures that lead to successful convictions of those suspects. He has been deployed for multiple incidents ranging from violent criminals, trackings, search warrants, school drug searches, pursuits, missing people, article searches, public demonstration, classroom visits, and helped convict suspects.

He enjoyed the attention from the public. The favorite memory was a building search for a suspect that had broken into a doctor's office. The K-9 announcement was made with no response from the suspect. As K-9 Richy started his search of the business, he located the subject and chased him, causing the suspect to jump out a window into the arms of the fellow officers that were securing the perimeter of the building.

K-9 Richy will retire to the good life of rest and relaxation living at home with Patrol Officer Kiner and his family. K-9 Richy has earned his retirement for the dedication and commitment to giving.

We extend our appreciation for Richy's years of loyal service and wish him a comfortable retirement.

Amending Section 20 of Ordinance No. 23-201 adopting personnel positions, pay grades, and salaries for certain employees of the City of Mansfield 2024 payroll year, by setting a pay range for the position of Forensic Investigator, and declaring an emergency.
