NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:



Accept and appropriate a Safety Intervention Grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) in the amount of Thirty-One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Five and 00/100 (\$31,465.00) for extrication equipment and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Safety Intervention Grant has been awarded to the City of Mansfield to provide funds for extrication equipment, with local matching funds to be in the amount of Ten Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Eight and 50/100 Dollars (\$10,488.50).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety-Service Director be, and is hereby, authorized on behalf of the City of Mansfield to accept a grant in the amount of Thirty-One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Five and 00/100 (\$31,465.00) from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for extrication equipment and to sign any and all documents necessary to receive said grant.

SECTION 2. That the sum of Thirty-One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Five and 00/100 (\$31,465.00) be, and the same is hereby, appropriated from the unappropriated Grant Fund (#224) to the Fire Grants (224.16.30) Capital Outlay Classification.
