The following conditions apply to this application:

- Old equipment shall remain on site for inspector to verify existing conditions and equipment.
- Smoke detection equipment shall be tested by the contractor during the inspection. Please have proper testing equipment on site during the inspection.
- Interior appliances that are changed to direct vent type appliances shall have old chimney connections removed and properly abandoned. The existing chimney and vent connections may need to be modified and/or chimney liners installed based on the new appliance input rating(s) that is/are connected to existing chimneys.
- Contractor shall request a final inspection upon completion of work. If any work will be concealed as a part of this application, a rough inspection shall be requested by the contractor and completed prior to concealing such work.
- Manufacturer's Installation Instructions for all equipment shall be provided and present on the project site for inspection purposes.

This application when approved will constitute a Certificate of Plan Approval in accordance with Ohio Building Code Section 105.5. Due to the minor nature of the inspection, an On-Site Inspection record will not be issued.
