DEBORAH MOUNT: Thank you Mr. President. I'd like to see of Director Ackerman could come up and explain these updates that they have.

DIRECTOR ADRIENNE ACKERMAN: Just a few updates. So, we did provide you all with a copy because there are a few on each page, so I think it is a little easier to understand kind of what needs to be changed. Simple language change on the first page in Section 1, should have said enacted as it does in the beginning instead of amended. So, that is one change. We also do need to have quotations for Walter Drane, correct? So, there's a quotation mark that begins as of #1370.01 for the portion that we will be adopting. Throughout the chapters and the sections, we also identified the relevant city ordinance that currently exist, that needed to be added to this. We do need to remove those from the actual ordinance itself. We won't be referencing those once the ordinances is in place. There is also one part, and I think it was changed in the legislation that we saw last week, and somehow ended up here. The civil penalty is currently at six-hundred dollars, not three-hundred. We modified that over the summer. Moved it from three to six. It's still in here as three because it has not been updated through Walter Drane, not yet. So, I just made that little note in there to reflect what it currently is. And then at the end of 1370.06, you will see the quotation marks. So, those are the changes that are recommended by the Law Director's office to make sure we are in compliance.

PRESIDENT PHIL SCOTT: Miss Mount.

DEBORAH MOUNT: If there's no more discussion on the first motion, at some point I would want to make a motion to....

PRESIDENT PHIL SCOTT: wait, Mr. Falquette had your hand up...

DAVID FALQUETTE: I did. My question follows, and I'll make a motion afterwards. I have not seen or received any phone calls, push back or emails of anything about this. I know there's support, skyping, sniping maybe on the internet as there normally is as with any change. But I would be willing to vote on this tonight. There's a lot of work to do, and I would move it forward unless somebody thinks there is a significant amount of pushback that some other changes need to be. But I think let Miss Mount make her motions first, get it cleaned up.
