
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:



SECTION 3. That this measure shall take effect and be in force after the earliest time allowed by law, after its passage and approval by the Mayor.



Authorizing the Public Works Director to enter into a Military Construction Cooperative Agreement (MCCA) with the National Guard Bureau, concerning the construction of an electrical substation and distribution system to serve the 179th Air National Guard Cyberspace Wing, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, representatives of the National Guard Bureau and the City of Mansfield are desirous of entering into a Military Construction Cooperative Agreement (MCCA) to facilitate the design and construction of a 138kV electrical substation and associated distribution system to support the 179th Air National Guard Cyberspace Wing mission; and

WHEREAS, this project is necessary to meet increased electrical demands associated with the conversion of the 179th Airlift Wing to a Cyber Operations mission, and includes improvements to serve new Cyber Operations facilities at the base; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mansfield is designated as the Grantee under the MCCA Project No. PBXP259002 and will act as a contracting agent for project delivery in accordance with the agreement, subject to reimbursement by the National Guard Bureau and in coordination with FirstEnergy for the connection to its transmission system; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is necessary to authorize execution of said agreement and to enable design and construction activities to proceed in accordance with applicable federal and local requirements;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1.

That the Public Works Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Mansfield a Military Construction Cooperative Agreement (Project No. PBXP259002) with the National Guard Bureau, relating to the planning, design, and construction of an electrical substation and distribution system to serve the 179th Air National Guard Cyber Wing mission at the Mansfield Lahm Regional Airport, all substantially in accordance with the proposed Cooperative Agreement as now on file with the City Engineers Office.

SECTION 2.

That the Public Works Director is further authorized to enter into any and all documents necessary to implement the purposes of the MCCA, including contracts for engineering design and construction of the facilities described therein, subject to the terms of the agreement.

Authorizing the Mayor, Safety-Service Director, Public Works Director and Human Resources Director to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), Local #3088, and declaring an emergency.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, Safety-Service Director, Public Works Director and Human Resources Director be, and they are hereby, authorized on behalf of the City of Mansfield, Ohio, to enter into a three-year Collective Bargaining Agreement with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), Local #3088, a copy of which Agreement will be available once executed in the Human Resources Department.

SECTION 2. That by reason of the immediate necessity for entering into said Agreement pursuant to the negotiations, and to promote harmony with City employees, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Mansfield and its inhabitants and providing it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption, otherwise from and after the earliest time allowed by law, after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
