
**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That the Public Works Director be, and he is hereby, authorized to accept a donation in the form of a Dogwood Tree, valued at One Hundred Fifty-six and 99/100 Dollars (\$156.99), to be planted at the front of the city building in honor of Kim Hildreth, for which the City expresses its sincere appreciation to Alta Florist and Greenhouse for its generous donation.

SECTION 2. That the sum of One Hundred Fifty-six and 99/100 Dollars (\$156.99), as accepted in Section 1 hereof be, and the same is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated General Fund (#101) to the Mayor's Operations (101.09.01) Supplies and Materials Classification.


SECTION 3. That by reason of the immediate necessity to accept the donation to be used by the City of Mansfield, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Mansfield and its inhabitants, providing it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption, otherwise from and after the earliest time allowed by law, after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
