Subject: Boil advisory issued

**Mansfield, OH-- Due** to a water main repairs it will be necessary to issue a boil advisory for the follow addresses:

Mapledale Avenue.

Highland Avenue from Mapledale Avenue to Euclid Avenue.

Under a boil advisory it is suggested that all consumed water be brought to a rolling boil for a full 3 minutes prior to consumption. This is a precautionary measure to be taken until samples can be tested to confirm water purity. A notice will be issued at the completion of the test. As a standard practice the USEPA recommends the following actions to reduce possible lead exposure in drinking water:

• If water has not been used for several hours, run the tap until there is a noticeable **temperature drop. Then, run water for 30 seconds to 3 minutes before using it for drinking and cooking.** This helps flush water that may have contained lead that may have leached from plumbing. **Use cold water for cooking, drinking, and preparing baby formula**. Boiling the water will not reduce lead.• **Clean your faucet aerator regularly.**
